Members of the South African Police Service (SAPS), Diepkloof police station, did not form part of the Operation Dudula raids on foreign-owned shops in Diepkloof. According to the SAPS' records, no fatalities of children, due to consumption of expired products purchased from foreign-owned spaza stores food in Diepkloof, were reported.
