- (1) With reference to the promotion of 11 364 members of the SA Police Service from 1 April 2022, what total number of the specified members are (a) black, (b) white, (c) brown and (d) Indian;
- (2) what total number of (a) black, (b) white, (c) brown and (d) Indian members were promoted in each relevant rank;
- (3) what was the initial rank in each case;
- (4) what number of the total number of members are (a) men and (b) women?

REPLY:

- (1) With reference to the promotion of 11 364 employees of the South African Police Service (SAPS), from 1 April 2022, which has since increased to 11 447 employees, the breakdown of number of employees are as follows:

(1)(a) Black:	8 861
(1)(b) White:	808
(1)(c) Brown:	1 517
(1)(d) Indian:	<u>261</u>
Total:	11 447

- (2)(a)(b)(c)(d) The information is reflected in the table below:
