1827. Mr H A Shemberi (EFF) to ask the Minister of Police:

- (1) What are the further developments in the case of the police officer who applied for a promotion to the rank of lieutenant-general in the technology management services division, who later disappeared with the state vehicle, office keys and phone when asked to present her qualifications;
- (2) whether there have been any arrests regarding the specified matter; if not, why not; if so, (a) who is the member and (b) what are the consequences of her actions to the SA Police Service?

REPLY:

- (1) The officer who was appointed as the Divisional Commissioner: Technology Management Services was booked off sick until recently. Several attempts to contact the officer were unsuccessful. In order to prevent any overpayment in salary, the officer's salary was frozen, and she will not receive a salary from May 2022 until the matter has been clarified. The South African Police Service (SAPS) is also considering the termination of the contract of the officer;
- (2) No arrests have been made in the matter. However, the following criminal cases have been opened against the officer: Sunnyside CAS 72/05/2022 (Use of Vehicle without Owner's Consent), and Sunnyside CAS 234/05/2022 (Malicious Damage to State Property). The said criminal cases are currently under investigation.


