1850. Ms A L A Abrahams (DA) to ask the Minister of Police:

- (1) With reference to Erf 5697, 56 Mossel Street, Churchill Estate, Cape Town, which has been declared a problem building by the City of Cape Town Metropolitan Municipality and has become a site for criminal activities placing the surrounding residents in danger, what is the total number of criminal cases and/or other history at the specified Erf that were reported to the SA Police Service (SAPS) Policing Station serving the jurisdictional area of the specified address in the past 10 years;
- (2) whether he has been informed of a sexual assault which had taken place at the Erf in the previous years;
- (3) what are the short-, medium- and long-term plans of the SAPS to combat criminal activities that take place at the Erf?

REPLY:

- (1) In the past 10 years, a total number of 10 criminal cases, at Erf 5697, 56 Mossel Street, Churchill Estate, Cape Town, were reported to the Parow police station, which serves the jurisdictional area of the specified address.
- (2) No sexual assault cases were reported.
- (3) The premises is not in a hot spot area, neither is it regarded as problematic, in terms of the crime patterns. There are regular patrols and visits to the premises.
