**NATIONAL ASSEMBLY QUESTION
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Mrs M O Clarke (DA) to ask the Minister of Defence and Military Veterans:

- (1) (a) Which company was awarded the tender for the 1 Military Hospital at Thaba Tshwane in Pretoria,
- (b) what total amount in funds were paid to the specified company and
- (c) has the company been blacklisted from doing business with the State;
- (2) Whether she will furnish Mrs M O Clake with the contract agreement, if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?

REPLY:

- (1) (a) The companies that were awarded tender during the Repair and Maintenance Programme (RAMP) under the DoD are the following:
- (i) Tectura Architects.
- (ii) CSIR.
- (iii) LDM Consulting (pty) Ltd.
- (b) The total amount paid to the above companies are the following:
- (i) Tectura Architects were paid R35 971 233-45.
- (ii) CSIR R2 542 270-00
- (iv) LDM Consulting (pty) Ltd were paid R9 893 772-00.
- (c) No, there were no actions from the Department of Defence to Blacklist these companies at this point in time.
- (2) The Accounting Officer has been directed to provide the relevant contracting documents to the honourable member.
