(a) What is the percentage of decisions to prosecute that were taken by the National Prosecuting Authority in the past financial year?


The Table below shows the details on the outcomes of the recommendations referred to the NPA. It can be observed that 1 347 of referrals to NPA the IPID is still waiting for response, 684 declined to prosecute, 53 NPA prosecuted and 9 withdrawn. The 53 cases where the NPA decided to prosecute stood at 3%.

(b) The SA Police Service disciplinary outcomes that are currently being on review by the Independent Police Investigative Directorate?

There is a total number of 16 cases that currently being reviewed by IPID on disciplinary outcomes. Of the 16 cases seven (7) were in Mpumalanga followed by Limpopo and Eastern Cape with four (4) and Gauteng Province with only one case. The rest of other Provinces reported zero on matters referred for review.
