2422. Ms A M Siwisa (EFF) to ask the Minister of Police:

Whether he has been informed that residents of Mohlakeng Township in Rand West City Local Municipality do not have access to a local police station and instead have to travel to Randfontein if they require assistance; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so, (a) why is the police station in Mohlakeng closed and (b) on what date will it be operational again?

REPLY:

- (a) The Mohlakeng satellite police station is currently not functional due to a shortage of personnel, at the Randfontein police station. In order to address this challenge, 62 newly recruited police members and 12 permanently appointed reservists, amounting to a total number of 74, were allocated to the Randfontein police station. These members are currently at the South African Police Service (SAPS) training academies, undergoing basic training. The permanently appointed reservists will be completing their training, in September 2022 and the newly recruited members will be completing their training, in December 2022.
- (b) It is envisaged that the Mohlakeng satellite police station will be operational from September 2022.
