#### REPLY:

- (a) The accused, Mr Sibusiso Kula, was arrested on 20 January 2023.
- (b) An arrest is effected only once there is evidence that links the suspect (not the accused) to the alleged offence and not on assumptions or suspicions. Once the investigation was concluded and there was reasonable evidence, the arrest was effected and the suspect, who has since been charged, is now the "accused" in a murder case.
