- (2) whether any cases involving serious crimes that were allegedly committed during the recent illegal strikes were reported to the SAPS; if not; what is the position in this regard; if so, what are the relevant details?

REPLY:

(1) The Directorate for Priority Crime Investigation (DPCI) continues to receive information, relating to various criminal activities including those occurring at Eskom. The following syndicates have been identified:

Coal Theft Syndicate

- · Four coal theft cases at court.
- Four accused arrested.

Eskom Conductor Cable Theft Syndicate

- Three cases at court.
- 14 accused arrested.

The Division: Crime Intelligence is currently collecting intelligence to identify criminal syndicates that are operating within and around Eskom, in support of the Division: Detective and Forensic Services and the DPCI.

During the recent Eskom illegal strike, various incidents were reported to the South African Police Service (SAPS), which led to several case dockets being registered. A total number of 310 cases were registered with the SAPS and 71 people were arrested.
