What is the current status of the implementation of the Just Transition to a Decarbonised Economy for South Africa?

2924. THE MINISTER OF FORESTRY, FISHERIES AND THE ENVIRONMENT REPLIES:

Cabinet approved the Just Transition Framework developed by the Presidential Climate Commission. Cabinet approved the Just Energy Transition Investment Plan (JET IP) that was submitted to the International Partner Group during COP26 in Egypt.

The Presidency established the Project Management Unit (PMU) to develop the implementation plan. The PMU is currently finalising the implementation plan for the JET IP. This comprehensive implementation plan will be submitted to Cabinet for approval before the end of the current calendar year. The JET IP is an important contribution towards a Just Transition to a decarbonised economy for South Africa.
