The main concern is that the Terminal Dues payments create economic distortions and result in considerable losses for some designated postal operators (including SAPO), thus undermining the sustainability of the universal service which the UPU network rely on. The outcome will be a signed agreement by member-states (Final Acts to be signed by the Minister).
