What is the latest information on the criminal charges laid by her department against the Ethekwini Metropolitan Municipality regarding the sewage crisis in the city of Durban?

3649. THE MINISTER OF FORESTRY, FISHERIES AND THE ENVIRONMENT REPLIES:

The Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) is currently investigating two cases against the eThekwini Metropolitan Municipality where sewage is concerned. The table below provides progress which was made in relation to these investigations to date.
