The South African Police Service (SAPS) is not aware of the incident that was reported by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), of a woman offering, her 4-year-old child for sale to paedophiles. This type of information could be posted on a number of platforms that are hosted on the clear web, such Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, WhatsApp (encrypted platform); and on the deep and dark web. Most of these social media platforms are managed (hosted) in the United States of America (USA).
