Whether User Acceptance Testing was done on the online application system that was developed for the Fishing Rights Allocation Process; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?

3755. THE MINISTER OF FORESTRY, FISHERIES AND THE ENVIRONMENT REPLIES:

Yes. User Acceptance Testing was done on the Fishing Rights Allocation Process (FRAP) online application System. After the system was tested by the developers, it was released for Acceptance testing. The department conducted User Acceptance Testing per module, finalised the users, roles, and access rights. Issues raised by the department were addressed and re-testing was done. The department approved the deployment of functionality and access rights to the production environment. After deployment to the production environment, the development team monitored and addressed any errors to ensure the system was stable.
