455. Mrs M O Clarke (DA) to ask the Minister of Police:

- (1) With regard to every police station in the Germiston constituency, (a) what total number of vehicles does the specified police station have on record and (b)(i) what number of the specified vehicles are in for repairs at the police garage in Benoni and (ii) for what length of time have the vehicles been at the garage for repair;
- (2) whether any confirmation can be provided as to what number of the vehicles have been returned to the garage for repairs for each police station; if not, why not; if so, what was the length of time during secondary repairs;
- (3) what total number of police officers at each police station have attended advanced driving courses;
- (4) what has the accident rate and/or ratio been at the specified police station?

REPLY:

(1)(a) A total number of 63 South African Police Service (SAPS) vehicles are currently allocated to the Germiston police station.

(b)(i) A total number of nine vehicles are currently booked in at the SAPS Benoni Garage.

(b)(ii) The requested details are reflected in the table below:

The nine vehicles have been at the SAPS Benoni Garage for varying periods of time, depending on the nature of the repairs that are required, as indicated below:

- Two vehicles have been at the Garage for six days;
- One vehicle for 10 days;
- One vehicle for 27 days;
- One vehicle for 59 days;

- One vehicle for 107 days;
 - One vehicle for 134 days;
 - One vehicle for 248 days; and
 - One vehicle for 288 days.
- (2) No vehicles have been returned to the garage for secondary repairs.
- (3) One SAPS member has attended an advanced driving course.
- (4) The accident rate is 12.7% for the current financial year, 1 April 2022 to 27 February 2023. The total number of accidents/collisions are eight out of the total number of 63 vehicles.
