803. Ms B M van Minnen (DA) to ask the Minister of Police:

With reference to his reply to question 364 on 2 March 2022, what are the top ten priorities of police stations to be constructed between (a) 1 January 2022 up to 31 December 2023 and (b) 1 January 2025 up to 31 December 2026 in the Western Cape?

REPLY:

- (a) No prioritised police stations are to be constructed in Western Cape, in the 2022/2023 and 2023/2024, financial years.
- (b) Out of the previous Western Cape provincial top priorities, the Tafelsig police station is scheduled for construction, in 2022/2023 and for completion in 2024/2025. Cognisance must be taken that the actual construction of the provincial prioritised top 10 police stations, will only commence after the completion of various construction phases, i.e. site clearance, planning and design and the acquisition of land.

The tables below reflect the current status of all active projects of the current and previous provincial priorities, for the Western Cape.


