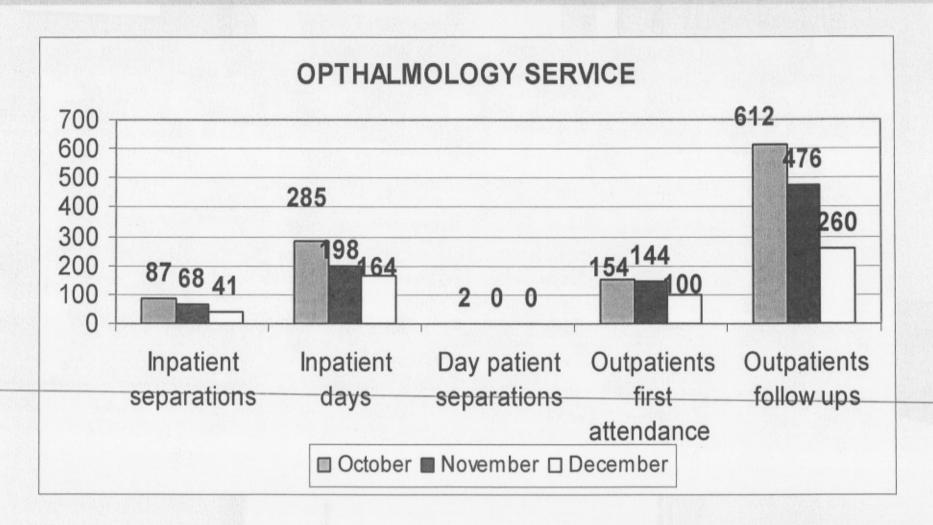
- Services of Renal dialysis unit expanded to 100 patients per week

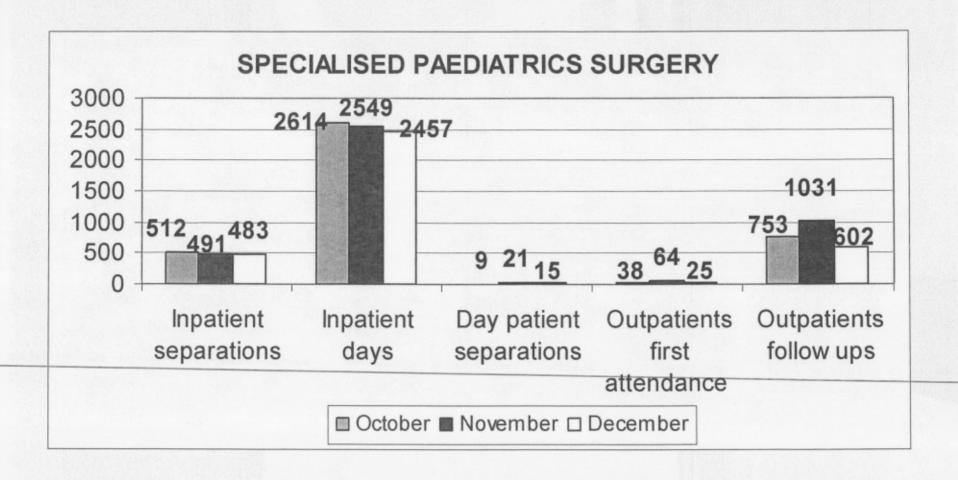

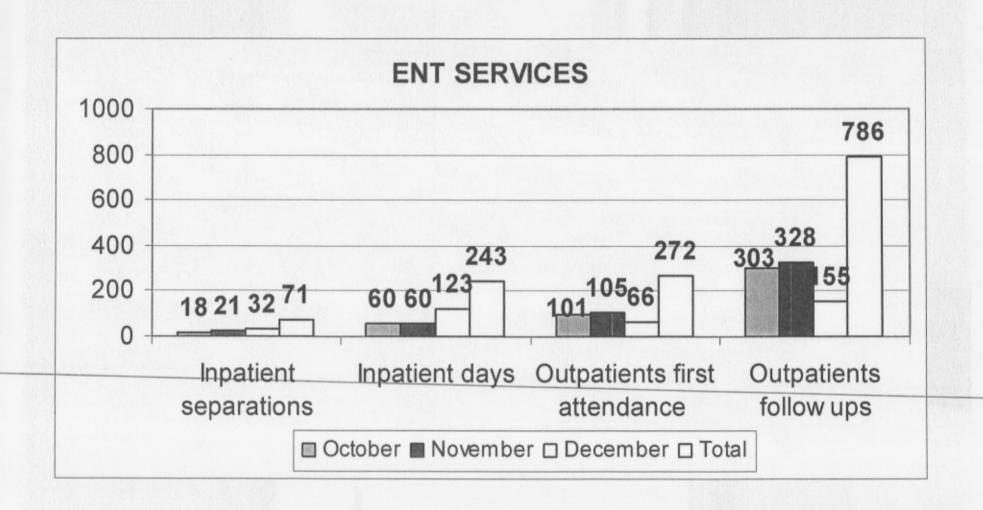

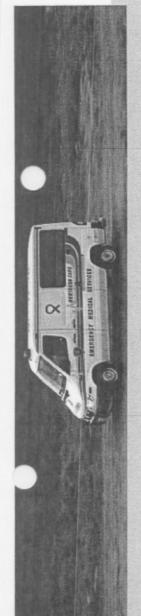






### **CHALLENGES**

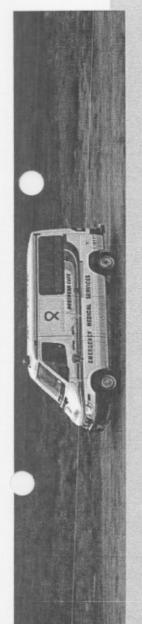
