Programme purposes:

Programme 2: comprehensive income support to the elders, the disabled and children in need through social assistance grants as provided for in law. Assess the social, economic and fiscal impact of social protection programmes.

Comment: we are requesting that the additional allocation of R 12.4 billion tabled by the minister of finance should include the establishment of special schools for slow learning and disabled people in the rural areas, to promote equality and prevention of unfair discrimination within our children in the rural areas in terms of (act no 4 of 2000).

Programme 3: policy development, review and implementation support for welfare services.

Purpose: develop, facilitate, monitor and evaluate the implementation of policies, legislation strategies and programmes on integrated social welfare services.

Comments: Department of Social Development must ensure that civil society organizations in partnership, is participating in matters relating to social development or service, before can be funded from the budget tabled by the minister of finance by referring to the previous job submitted to the Department of Social Development from that particular organization.
