Funding heritage projects in the 2008-2009 financial year

Since inception of the Funding Unit in 2005 and the funding systems put in place, the National Heritage Council has afforded the public opportunities to access funding through advertising processes. The Heritage Funding Committee sits twice a year to assess and award qualifying proposals. However, the Department of Arts & Culture has requested that an amount of R16M be ring-fenced for projects and programmes that support the Minister's National Imperatives. It is going to be necessary for the NHC to review its support to public for the same financial year and into the future.

Monitoring and evaluation of Funded Projects

Leap Digital, a service provider engaged to do monitoring, evaluation & reporting to approved projects, meets regularly with the Funding and Resource Mobilization Unit to give feedback on visited funded projects. Leap Digital submits reports on achievements/successes, challenges or flashpoints where necessary and these are addressed with funded projects through funding operational processes. An impact study report will be produced reflecting the impact of NHC funding since inception.
