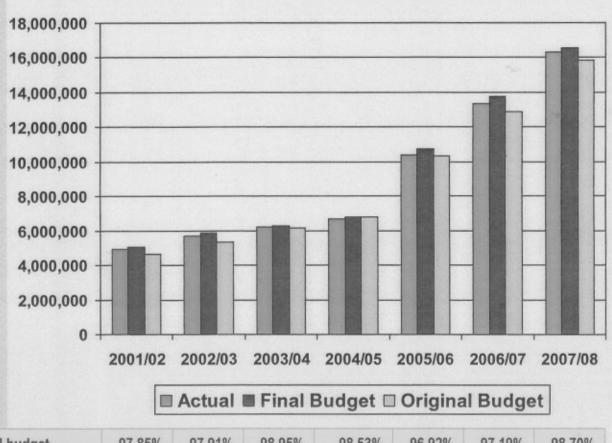

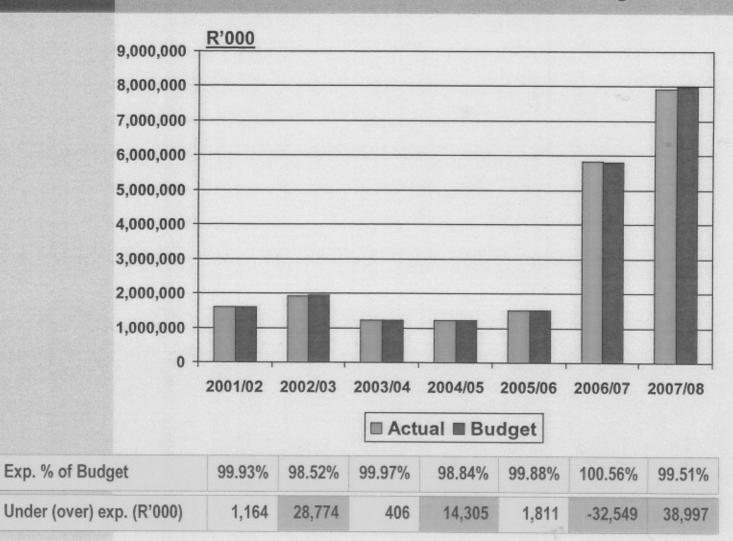

2002/03: Considerable delays were experienced to conclude an agreement with the Eastern Cape Department of Transport for the transfer of R28 million for the revival of the Kei railway line between Umtata and East London. Consensus was only reached in March 2003 to enter into an agreement. The amount was rolled over to the next financial year as a Transfer Payment and paid in 2004/05.

2004/05: Assistance to Provinces for overloading control was under spent by R13,5 million because of delays by stakeholders to submit business plans. The amount was not rolled over.

2006/07: Upgrading and construction of Botswana River Crossings budgeted under Goods and Services spent as Capital Expenditure R35m

2007/08: Under expenditure on Sani Pass (R30m) and Overload Control facilities (R8,2m) – due to mechanism of payment and ownership of assets unresolved at that stage. <a href="mailto:Expected to be rolled over and paid">Expected to be rolled over and paid</a> as Conditional Grants in 2007/08
