## Background

- o Population of 5.4 million
- o 92% rural
- o Children 0-4 is 675 500
- o Most ECD centres are in remote rural areas
- > Mopani , Sekhukhune and Vhembe

#### Status of ECD centres

- ◆ Total registers ECD centres is 1573
- ◆ Total number of children in ECD centres is 70 785
- Number subsidised is 1093
- Children subsidised at R9.00 per child per day per attendance
- The claims are paid monthly upon submission

#### Status of ECD centres

- Funding is done through means test
  - > Proof of income required from parents
  - e.g. parent with one child earning less than R1800 per month
  - Parent with 3 children earning less than R2240 per month
- ♦ 95% of beneficiaries resides in rural areas

#### CHALLENGES

- Inadequate staff to register and support the sites
- Capacity of ECD staff to submit claims timeously
- Inadequate budget to subsidise all registered sites
- Carers not provided with stipend/salary
- Incapacity of communities to provide ECD infrastructure
- Most children not accessing ECD sites

#### INTERVENTION

- Recruitment and retention of Social Workers through bursary scheme
- Training of Auxiliary Social Workers and deploy them to communities
- Capacity building of ECD sites
- Coordinate with Municipalities on establishment of ECD sites
