ACHIEVE HIGHER RATES OF INVESTMENT IN THE ECONOMY

- There was greater commitment by government to invest in basic ICT infrastructure.
- ① The Electronic Communications Act was amended to facilitate government investment in strategic ICT infrastructure, thus enabling the licensing of Infraco.
- ① A business plan for the establishment of the National Wireless Broadband Network by Sentech was developed – which is the basis to connect 500 Dinaledi Schools.

INCREASING COMPETITIVENESS OF THE SA ECONOMY

- Due to the sensitive nature of the information provided by the sector, an information management protocol was adopted to facilitate the development of the Integrated Infrastructure Plan across government departments.
- ① The implementation of the 2010 ICT guarantees as well as the FIFA Confederation Cup commenced and is on track.
- Policy guidelines on the rapid deployment of electronic communications facilities were developed.

- The ICT Skills Development Strategy was finalised.
- The e-Skills Council was established to develop and implement interventions to address the shortage of ICT skills in South Africa.
- Initial funding was allocated for Sentech's wireless broadband roll-out.
- The concept document for the Meraka e-Skills Institute was developed.
- Phase one of Sentech's wireless broadband network has commenced – the mapping of the 233 Dinaledi Schools, with the related government sites, has been completed.
- Occurrence with the development of the Set Top Box Subsidy Policy.
- © Commenced with the development of the strategy for the development of the Set Top Box Manufacturing sector.
- The proposed Set Top Box Specifications were completed.

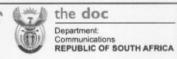



- The Protocol on the Policy and Regulatory Framework for the NEPAD ICT Broadband Infrastructure Network for Eastern and Southern Africa was ratified by Parliament.
- ① Progress was made with regards to the construction of the international submarine cable, UhuruNet and the terrestrial cable, UmojaNet.
- ① NEPAD e-schools Demo project was launched.
- ① Participated the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) ICT programmes as observers.

 - ① Global Alliance for ICTs for Development (GAID).
- The only business-to-business agreement signed at the IBSA Summit, was submitted by the Information Society Working Group.

ACHIEVE HIGHER RATES OF INVESTMENT IN THE ECONOMY

- ① Forum of South African Directors General (FOSAD) on Information Society and Development (ISAD) Cluster was established with its 8 subcommittees.
- Priority attention was given to Apex Priority 3, which is aimed at increasing the uptake and usage of ICTs by individuals and government.
- Provided both the secretariat and professional support for the ISAD Cluster and its sub-committees through the development and implementation of a Framework for the Professional and Secretariat Support.

- O PNC also focused on the preparations of the Presidential International Advisory Council (PIAC) on ISAD meeting that was held in August 2007 which entailed consultation with the government, business and academia and eventually the e-Skills Council was launched in August 2007 at the PIAC meeting.
- The PNC provided professional support to the ISAD IGR Forum meetings.
- Municipal Websites Portal launched and maintained by e-cooperatives.

INCREASING COMPETITIVENESS OF THE SA BOOKOM

- The National Youth ISAD Programme was launched together with three projects targeting young people, namely, e-Cooperatives, National Digital Repository (NDR) for Cultural Heritage, Youth e-Literacy
- A total of 460 young people were recruited in all 9 provinces.
- 40 Youth e-Cooperatives have been formed and registered with Companies and Intellectual Property Registration Office (CIPRO).
- •-Cooperatives were trained and had an opportunity to apply their skills through the development and support of municipal websites in Mpumalanga.
