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## INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

#### Mechanism of NIPP

- NIP became obligatory in September 1996 when the programme and its design was approved by Parliament
- NIP obligation arises when imported goods and services are procured by Government and the import content value equals or exceeds US\$ 10m
- Obligation value is 30% of imported content value



# INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

#### Mechanism of NIPP

- 5% Performance Guarantee is required by SA Government from obligors
- Obligation is discharged over 7 year period by the generation of economic activity equal to the obligation value

Three main areas covered by the NIPP

- NIP arising out of Defence Procurement
- NIP arising out of Non-Defence Procurement
- Strategic Partnership Agreements



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
