

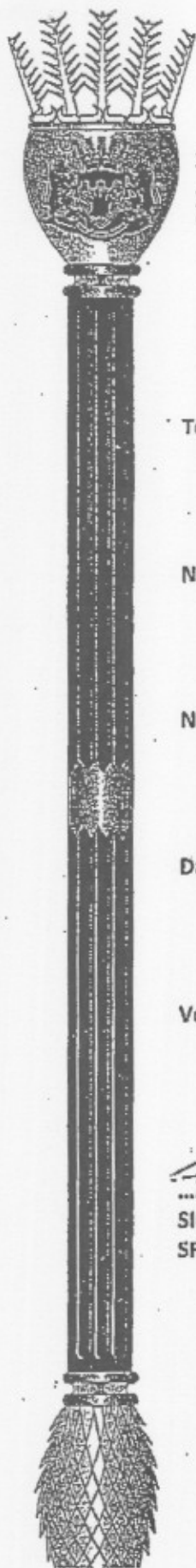

1. TERMS OF REFERENCE

The above mentioned Bills were referred to the Portfolio Committee for consideration as a matter of priority.

2. BRIEFING

On the 23rd February 2009, Hon. L. Moseki, NCOP Permanent Delegate briefed the members of the Portfolio Committee on Developmental Local Government, Housing and Provincial Affairs on the above Bills.
