1 INTRODUCTION

The Chairperson of the Finance Portfolio Committee, Mr B S Nkosi tables a report on the Final Voting Mandate of the Division of Revenue Bill [B4-2009] taking into account the comments and recommendations made in Negotiating Mandate which was adopted on the Thursday, 26 February 2009.

2 PROCESS FOLLOWED

The Speaker referred the Bill to the Portfolio Committee of Finance formally for consideration in terms of Gauteng Provincial Legislature Standing Rules 232(1) read with 235(4); (6) and (7) on 18 February 2009. The Bill was passed by the National Assembly and transmitted to the NCOP for concurrence on 13 February 2009.

Each financial year when the annual budget is introduced, the Minister of Finance must in terms of Section 10 of the Intergovernmental Fiscal Relations Act, 1997 (Act No 97 of 1990) ("the Act"), introduce in the National Assembly a Division of Revenue Bill for the financial year to which that budget relates. The Financial and Fiscal Commission presented its recommendations to the Committee on the Division of Revenue 2009/2010 financial year.

The Committee began its deliberations on the Bill on 26 February 2009 when briefed by the NCOP delegate Mr EM Sogoni, and the Finance

Portfolio Committee adopted its Final Voting Mandate on Tuesday, 10 March 2009 for tabling in the House on Thursday, 12 March 2009.

3 PRINCIPLE OF THE BILL AND GOVERNMENT'S POLICY PRIORITIES FOR THE 2009/10 MTEF

The Bill seeks to provide for the equitable division of revenue raised nationally among the three spheres of government for the 2009/2010 financial year and the responsibilities of all three spheres pursuant to such divisions; and to provide for matters connected therewith. The 2009 medium term expenditure framework is guided by the following principles:

- · Protecting the poor;
- Sustaining employment growth and expanding training opportunities;
- · Building economic capacity and promoting investment;
- Addressing the barriers to competitiveness that limit an equitable sharing of opportunities; and
- · Maintaining a sustainable debt level

4 OPINION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ON THE BILL

Before the Bill is tabled in Parliament, all Provincial Treasuries are afforded an opportunity to comment, as such, inputs of the Provincial Executive Committee are captured on the Bill. Therefore Gauteng Treasury concurs with the Bill as tabled.

5 PRNCIPLE AND DETAIL OF THE BILL

The Portfolio Committee on Finance supports the Principle and Detail of the Division of Revenue Bill [B4-2009].

6 FINAL VOTING POSITION ADOPTED BY THE COMMITTEE

In terms of Section 65 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, the Finance Committee recommends to the House to confer authority to the Gauteng Provincial Legislature Delegate/s in the National Council of Provinces to **vote in favour** of the Division of Revenue Bill [B4-2009].

- The Committee was briefed by the NW Permanent Delegate
 Hon Kolwent on the 17th February 2009. On the same day a
 public hearing was held with the Provincial Treasury.
- 2 The Committee further conducted public hearings organised in the following manner:

- 3 The Committee is satisfied that public hearings as indicated above broadly represented critical constituencies and important stakeholders in the Province.
- Arising out of these public hearings and the Committee's deliberations on the Division of Revenue Bill, the following points need to be considered by the NCOP in processing this piece of legislation:
- There is a need for a clear and unambiguous clarification on the Sixteenth Constitutional Amendment Bill and it is implications on North West's equitable share for the year 2009/10.
- National Treasury will have to advise on the proper legal framework and mechanism to be followed on how NW and Gauteng will share funding commitments in Merafong from their respective 2009/10 equitable shares.
- A firm proposal from the North West is that National Treasury should make additional funding available to smoothen the transition of Merafong from the North West Into Gauteng, with the understanding that the full financial impact on the North West will be deferred until 1 April 2010.

Recommendation

5 Having made these observations the North West Provincial Legislature mandates its Permanent Delegates in the National Council of Provinces to support and vote in favour of the Division of Revenue Bill [B 4 - 2009].
