

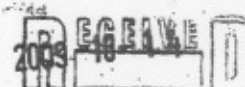

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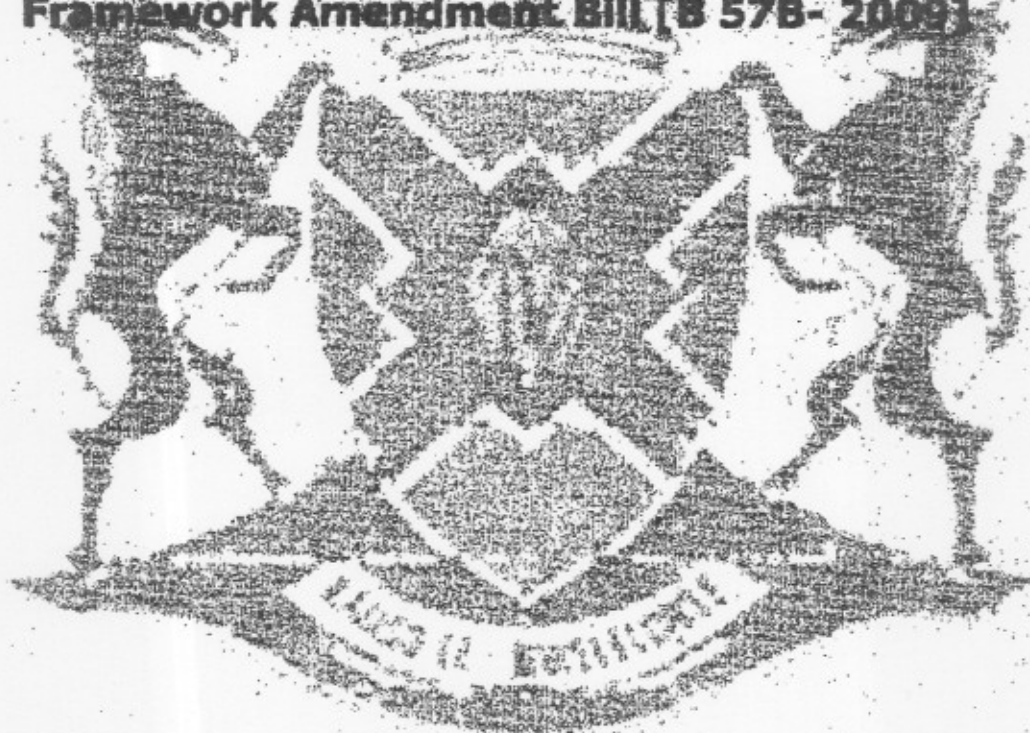

Terms of Reference

The Bills were referred to the Portfolio Committee on Local Government and Traditional Affairs for consideration as a matter of priority

Briefing

- 2.1 On the 18 September 2009, Hon E. Chaane, an NCOP Permanent delegate, attended the briefing of the Portfolio Committee on Local Government and Traditional Affairs on the Bills.
- 2.2 Present at the briefing were Committee members the Legislature's legal advisor, delegates from the House of Traditional Leaders in the Province (including the deputy chairperson and secretary) and other members and an official from the DPSA.

Consideration

The Committee, having considered the Bill, resolved to accept and support the same to the following extent:

- (a) The Bill is accepted with the exclusion of the proposed clause 9A(2)-(5) in as far as they relate to the establishment of a new tier in the levels of traditional leadership. That, as many comments have been noted, constitutes an unwarranted relegation of senior traditional leaders to third

traditional leaders will these above have once they have been declared by the Commission to be of lower position than that of Kingship / Queenship, as the case may be.

Resolution

After the committee's consideration on the Bill, the Resolution taken was

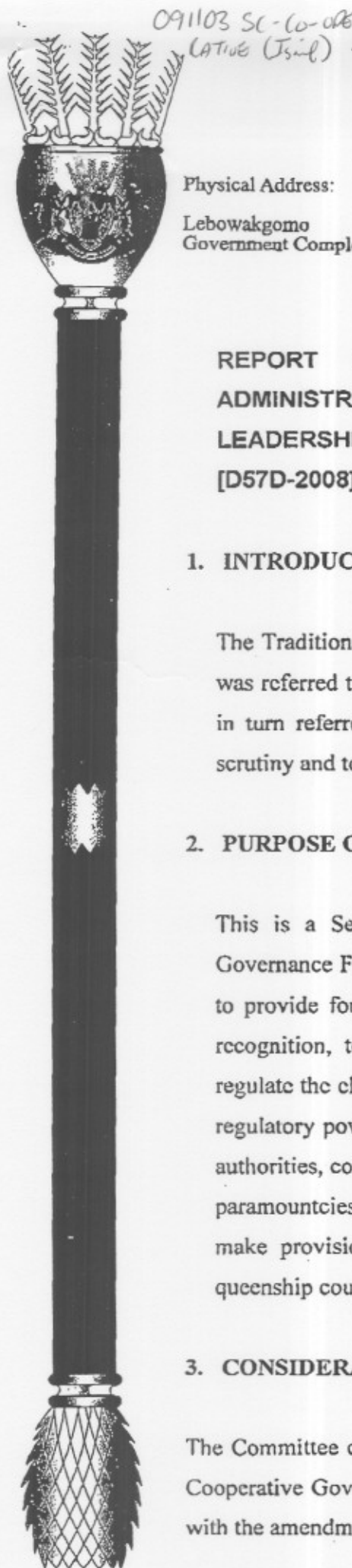
- a. To support the principle and detail of the Bill

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REPORT OF THE PORTFOLIO COMMITTEE ON PROVINCIAL ADMINISTRATION OF THE LIMPOPO LEGISLATURE ON THE TRADITIONAL LEADERSHIP AND GOVERNANCE FRAMEWORK AMENDMENT BILL [D57D-2008]

1. INTRODUCTION

The Traditional Leadership and Governance Framework Amendment Bill (B57B) 2008, was referred to the Legislature by the National Council of Provinces and the Legislature in turn referred the Bill to the Portfolio Committee on Provincial Administration for scrutiny and to report to the House.

2. PURPOSE OF THE BILL

This is a Section 76 Bill which seeks to amend the Traditional Leadership and Governance Framework Act, 2003, so as to substitute a definition and insert a definition; to provide for the recognition of Kingship and queenship and the withdrawal of such recognition, to provide for the establishment of sub- traditional councils; to further regulate the election of members of local houses of traditional leaders; to provide for the regulatory powers; to provide anew for the transitional provisions relating to traditional authorities, community authorities and paramountcies; to provide for the establishment of paramountcies; to amend Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1998, so as to make provision for the remuneration of none- traditional councils and kingship or queenship councils; and to provide for matters connected thereto.

3. CONSIDERATION OF THE BILL


The Committee considered the amendments forwarded by the NCOP Select Committee on Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs on 30 October 2009 and resolved to agree with the amendments.

4. RECOMMENDATIONS.

The Committee recommends to the House that the final mandate be conferred to permanent delegate of the National Council of Provinces in favour of the Bill to pass into Law.

5. CONCLUSION

I hereby move that this report be adopted as a report of this House and I move accordingly.
