Proposed Amendments Commission on Gender Equality Act No.39 of 1996

- I seek to propose amendments to the Commission on Gender Equality Act No 39 of 1996, Subsection 11 (3) by adding the following phrases to the following clauses respectively:
 - (f) shall as far as is practicable maintain close liaison with institutions, bodies or authorities with similar objectives to the Commission, in order to foster common policies and practices and to promote co-operation in relation to the hand-ling of complaints in cases of overlapping jurisdiction or other appropriate instances; both within the Republic and Internationally
 - (g) shall liaise and interact with any organisation which actively promotes gender equality and other sectors of civil society to further the object of the Commission; both within the Republic and internationally
 - (h) shall monitor the compliance with international conventions, international covenants and international charters, acceded to or ratified by the Republic, relating to the object of the Commission, and shall go so when gender rights of South Africans are violated outside the Republic of South Africa.

I further seek to add an extra function which reads as follows:

 Shall actively champion the gender rights of South Africans when such rights are violated outside the Republic of South Africa.

Proposed Amendments to the Human Rights Commission Act No.54 of 1994

- I seek to propose amendments to the Human Rights Commission Act No.54 of 1994, by adding the following clause to Subsection 7(e)
- 7(e) may bring proceedings in a competent court or tribunal, including international courts and tribunals, in its own name, or on behalf of a person or a group or class of persons
