

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO 2010 HEALTH REGULATIONS ("draft Regulations")**

**Amendment of Regulation 4:**

**Request for approval of medicines, Scheduled substances and medical devices**

4. A request for approval of medicines, Scheduled substances and medical devices that may be used by an accredited foreign medical contingent referred to in section 3(3)(a) of the Act, must be submitted in a form similar to **Annexure "C" Part 1.**

**Deletion of Regulations 5 and 6:**

Regulations 5 and 6 of the draft Regulations **must be deleted** as instructed by the State Law Advisers as they are merely repeating the empowering provisions of the 2<sup>nd</sup> FIFA WORLD CUP SA SPECIAL MEASURES ACT.

**Proposed insertion of new Regulations 5 and 6:**

**"Approval of medicines, Scheduled substances and medical devices**

**5. The approval of medicines, Scheduled substances and medical devices granted by the Minister of Health in terms of section 3(1) of the Act, must be in a form similar to Annexure "C" Part 2."**

**Insertion of new regulation 6:** Department of Health to insert a provision that compels accredited medical contingents to take all medicines, Scheduled substances and medical devices out of SA back to its country of origin after the conclusion of World Cup.

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Dear Sir

As medicine providers to the general public we anticipate a large number of international visitors whose medication laws differ in their country of residence.

Many of these visitors will arrive and try to organise last minute tours especially of the Game Parks. They will be unaware that **anti-malarial medication** is required for the vast majority of game parks.

These medications are currently only obtainable on Doctors prescription in South Africa; Relaxation of this specific law would enable tourists to obtain the medication from pharmacies without having to find a Doctor in an unknown country and possibly in a foreign language. It would also enable the tourist to make last-minute plans for game parks without the fear of contracting malaria if time &/or cost of visiting a Doctor is prohibitive

Please consider this as a possible exemption for the duration of the FIFA cup
