

DHA FIFA World Cup 2010 Project Report

DHA made the following Commitments to FIFA:

Government Guarantee 4.1:

That **Visas** will be issued to a broad range of persons (including members of the FIFA Delegation and Commercial Affiliates, media representatives and foreign visitors).

Government Guarantee 4.2:

That **Work Permits** will be issued (where required) to a broad range of persons (including members of the FIFA Delegation and the Commercial Affiliates and Media Representatives)

Government Guarantee 4.11:

That **Priority Treatment** will be provided for the FIFA delegation, teams and other accredited persons at Ports of Entry

Project 1: Dedicated Express Lanes for Airports

Relationship/ Impact on FIFA commitment	Government Guarantee 4.11: That Priority Treatment will be provided for the FIFA delegation, teams and other accredited persons at Ports of Entry
Objective	Create effective processing/ clearing capacity at Airports targeting 80% of travelers and to provide Priority Treatment for FIFA Accredited Persons
Status and Next Steps	 We have produced branding material for the creation of Dedicated Express lanes at the three (3) targeted Airports (OR Tambo, Cape Town and King Shaka) Our Go Live date for the deployment of branding material is Monday 24/05/2010 Team Terminal has been Identified and will be ready for operations from Monday 24/05/2010 New Movement Control Technology System has been installed and is fully operational Additional Human Resource Capacity will be deployed on the 24/05/2010



Project 2: Temporary Joint Border Clearance Facility for Land Ports (Core Located Borders)

Relationship/ Impact on FIFA commitment	Government Guarantee 4.11: That Priority Treatment will be provided for the FIFA delegation, teams and other accredited persons at Ports of Entry
Objective	Create Mass Clearance Facility for the identified six (6) Land Ports with anticipated high traveler volume and to provide Priority Treatment for FIFA Accredited Persons
Identified six (6) Land Ports	Beitbridge – Zimbabwe Kopfontein –Botswana Maseru and Ficksburg – Lesotho Lebombo – Mozambique Oshoek – Swaziland
Status and Next Steps	 Rollout and deployment of logistical items and equipment for the setting up of the core located borders has commenced and will be fully operational on the 24/05/2010 Rollout of the New Movement Control Technology System has been completed and fully operational
	Additional Human Resource Capacity will be deployed on the 24/05/2010 6



Project 3: Joint Clearance Task Team

Relationship/ Impact on FIFA commitment	Government Guarantee 4.11: That Priority Treatment will be provided for the FIFA delegation, teams and other accredited persons at Ports of Entry
Objectives	To establish a 24 hour Clearance Task Team by DHA and FIFA/NIA to co-manage potential cases of FIFA Accredited Persons with compliance problems
Achievements	Engaged and agreed with FIFA on the creation of the Task Team
Next Steps	 Deploy identified persons with the appropriate level of authority by the 25/05/10 at three (3) identified Airports Task team to be set up and deployed on the 24/05/2010 at the three (3) identified Airports and will also support Land Ports




Project 4: 24hr Ticket/Voucher Validation Unit


Relationship/ Impact on FIFA commitment	Government Guarantee 4.1: That Visas will be issued to a broad range of persons (including members of the FIFA Delegation and Commercial Affiliates, media representatives and foreign visitors).	
Objective	Create capacity to support Foreign Mission to issue Event VISA for Countries Requiring VISA	
Status and Next Steps	 Created a 24 hour Validation Unit to verify and confirm the unique number appearing on the match certificates/vouchers and this process is currently on track. We have created an interface and link with FIFA for the transfer of Data for two (2) most important lists namely: FIFA Accredited Persons and Match Ticket Vouchers for overseas spectators. 	



Project 5: FIFA Large Account Unit

Relationship/ Impact on FIFA commitment	Government Guarantee 4.2: That Work Permits will be issued (where required) to a broad range of persons (including members of the FIFA Delegation and the Commercial Affiliates and Media Representatives)	
Objective	Create dedicated capacity to issue Work Permits for members of the FIFA Delegation and the Commercial Affiliates and Media Representatives	
Status and Next Steps	As at 16 May 2010 we have issued 3500 Work Permits and we continue to issue as we receive application. We are satisfied that we have fully complied and met the requirement of this Guarantee.
