# NATIONAL TEAMS

- RELEASE OF PLAYERS
- DEFFIENCIES ON DEVELOPMENT OF PLAYERS
- POLICY FOR JUNIOR NATIONAL TEAMS ON RELEASE OF PLAYERS
- JUNIOR NATIONAL TEAM COACHES MUST BE SOUTH AFRICANS



# PSL AND 1<sup>ST</sup> DIVISION

- COACHES MUST CARRY THE HIGHEST COACHING QUALIFICATION
- 1<sup>ST</sup> DIVISION MUST BE COACHED BY SOUTH AFRICANS
- ✓ • FOREIGN COACHES QUALIFICATIONS MUST BE SCRUTINISED
- ASSISTANT COACHES MUST BE SOUTH AFRICANS
- ALL PSL AND 1<sup>ST</sup> DIVISION TEAMS MUST HAVE AT LEAST 3 DEVELOPMENT TEAMS

# PSL AND 1<sup>ST</sup> DIVISION

- NOT MORE THAN 3 FOREIGN PLAYERS ALLOWED IN OUR LEAGUE
- TEAMS MUST NOT REGISTER MORE THAN 28 PLAYERS
- PLAYERS WHO HAVE REPRESENTED THEIR COUNTRIES MUST NOT BE GIVEN PERMANENT CITIZENSHIP STATUS
- 
- YOUNG PLAYERS MUST PLAY AT LEAST 25 % GAMES PER SEASON

# AMATEUR FOOTBALL

- THE COACHES AT THIS LEVEL MUST BE SOUTH AFRICANS
- ALL COACHES MUST HAVE A QUALIFICATION



# YOUTH AND SCHOOL

- IDENTIFY FOOTBALL SCHOOLS
- QUALIFIED COACHES MUST BE EMPLOYED
- CONCENTRATE ON SCHOOL LEAGUE AS OPPOSED TO TOURNAMENTS
- HAVE A LEAGUE STRUCTURE FOR ALL AGE GROUPS(AVOID CHEATING)

# GRASSROOTS

- ALL SCHOOLS MUST BE INVOLVED IN GRASSROOTS FOOTBALL
- QUALIFIED COACH EDUCATORS TO BE TRAINED TO RUN THIS PROGRAM
