**1. INTRODUCTION**

The Chairperson of the Finance Portfolio Committee, Hon. Mr. Anthony Hope Mankwana Papo, tables the Portfolio Committee's Final Voting Mandate on the Division of Revenue Amendment Bill [B35-2010], a Section 76 Bill as follows:

**2. PROCESS FOLLOWED.**

At the meeting held on Tuesday, 09 November 2010 the Portfolio Committee deliberated and adopted the Final Voting Mandate on the Division of Revenue Amendment Bill [B35-2010].

**3. PRINCIPAL AND DETAIL OF THE BILL**

The Division of Revenue Amendment Bill seeks to:

- Amend the Division of Revenue Act, 2010

The aim of the amendments is to provide for the equitable division of revenue raised nationally among the national, provincial and local spheres of government for the 2010/11 financial year and the responsibilities of all three spheres pursuant to such division; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

**4. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS AND SOCIO ECONOMIC IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF THE  
BILL FOR THE PROVINCE**

**4.1. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS OF THE BILL**

The financial implications are limited to the transfer of funds to relevant Provincial departments.

#### **4.2. SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT**

The view of the Portfolio Committee is that the amendments to the Bill seek to accelerate service delivery by ensuring that GPG departments spent allocated funds. Furthermore, this is in line with the priorities of the Province.

#### **5. FINAL VOTING MANDATE POSITION ADOPTED BY COMMITTEE**

In terms of Section 65 of the Constitution, the Finance Portfolio Committee recommends that the House confer authority on the Gauteng Provincial Delegate/s to the National Council of Provinces to **vote in favour** of the Division of Revenue Amendment Bill [B35-2010].
