

[B16B - 2010]

#### CLAUSE 12

- On page 8, after line 54, to insert the following subsection:
  - "(2) The provisions of section 7(1), (3) and (4) apply, with the necessary changes, to the designation or filling of a vacancy in terms of subsection (1)."
- On page 9, in line 2, to omit "one year" and substitute "six months".

#### CLAUSE 18

On page 10, in line 15, to omit "in" and substitute "after".

#### CLAUSE 21

- On page 11, after line 2, to insert the following subsection:
  - "(2) The provisions of section 18(1), (3) and (4) apply, with the necessary changes, to the designation or filling of a vacancy in terms of subsection (1)."
- On page 11, in line 4, to omit "six" and substitute "three".

#### CLAUSE 26

- On page 12, in line 16, after "secretariat" to insert "in accordance with section 100 of the Constitution".
- 2. On page 12, from line 23 up and including line 31, to omit subsections (2) to (5).

REPORT OF THE PORTFOLIO COMMITTEE ON SAFETY, SECURITY AND LIAISON ON CIVILIAN SECRETARIAT FOR POLICE SERVICE BILL[16B-2010

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The Civilian Secretariat for Police Service Bill [B16B-2010] was referred to the Limpopo Legislature by the National Council of Provinces (NCOP). The Bill was then referred to the Portfolio Committee of Safety, Security and Liaison. Subsequently, a negotiating mandate was conferred to Limpopo NCOP Delegates to negotiate in favor of the Bill. It is against this background that the Committee begs to report to this Honourable House for the formal conferral of a final mandate to the NCOP Delegates to support the Bill as amended.

#### 2. CONSIDERATION OF THE AMENDMENTS MADE ON THE BILL

The Portfolio Committee, having considered the amendments made on the Bill by the Select Committee on Security and Constitutional Affairs, found that the amendments are not affecting the substance and principle of the Bill but make the provisions of the Bill more obligatory.

#### 3. RECOMMENDATION

The Portfolio Committee having considered and supported the Bill by the Select Committee on Security and Constitutional Affairs recommends to this House to confer a final mandate to the NCOP Permanent Delegates to support the Bill as agreed upon by the Select Committee and to vote in favor of the Bill to be passed into law.

#### 4. CONCLUSION

In conclusion, I move that this report be adopted as a report of this august House and that a final mandate be conferred to the NCOP Delegates accordingly. I so move, Honourable Speaker.
