MTN's RICA campaigns/initiatives




- In November 2010, MTN stated that we will be:
 - increasing our investment in RICA marketing campaigns and initiatives;
 - "taking RICA to the people"
 - increasing our RICA points of presence
- MTN has invested more than R150 million since the effective date of RICA (i.e. 1 July 2009)
- MTN continues to invest significant financial and human resources in our RICA initiatives and campaigns in order to ensure that our customers are RICA'ed - MTN will be investing an estimated R40 to R50 million on RICA campaigns in 2011.

MTN has gone to 6500 points of presence, which includes

MTN's below-the-line RICA campaigns



- MTN has taken RICA buses to visit rural areas areas where there are large concentrations of customers that have not RICA'ed and other public areas (such as Taverns and Shopping Malls)
- The RICA bus travels to residential areas (both formal and informal) to RICA customers
- Each RICA bus has a trailer, with sound equipment, stage and portable RICA facilities
- Entertainment is provided and customers have an opportunity to win prizes when they are RICA'd



RICA Status




Our customers need to be informed about their RICA status and this is made available through various technology platforms.

- USSD, the customer dials *131# to check their RICA status (only available to pre-paid customers at this point in time)
- MTN website
- Customers can call the MTN prepaid and post-paid call centres to enquire about their RICA status

MTN's initiatives to register customers in the rural areas



- As mentioned previously, MTN utilises RICA buses to RICA customers in rural areas, which is proving to be effective
- In addition, MTN Zoners are also deployed to rural areas to RICA customers
- An MTN RICA point-of-presence will be located at certain government departments in rural areas
- MTN also proactively identifies customers that are not RICA'd and reside in rural areas

Key challenge to register customers in the rural areas



- Customers that reside in rural areas have difficulty in providing proof of residence
- MTN has introduced a template affidavit to assist customers in providing proof of residence
- However, the proof of address from the retail store, church or school is not an effective solution because customers are required to find a church, retail store or school to complete and then return to the RICA point
