**AN APPEAL AGAINST THE WITHDRAWAL OF SUBSIDY FOR SELECTED
EASTERN CAPE INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS.**

We wish to appeal to your office to intervene on our behalf the decision taken by the Eastern Cape Provincial School's Subsidy Section regarding the withdrawal of 2010/11 financial year's subsidy.

The affected schools are:

- a) Kings Commercial College
- b) Science College International
- c) Christ the King International School
- d) St. Martins Private School
- e) St. Jude Private School
- f) Umtata College of Maths & Science

We would like to further put it to your attention that the pressure put on principals of Public Schools by the same Department of Education to perform leads to discrimination of learners on placement as they are subjected to interviews during admission. The schools also fail to re-admit Grade 12 learners when they fail without alternative. These leave children (learners) with no option but to be in the streets and may lead to the following:

1. High crime rate for which our same government is working against,
2. Unwanted social dependence which leads to unwanted teenage pregnancy and high rate of HIV/AIDS infections
3. Refusal of the learners the right to access education, a right enshrined in the

Constitution of South Africa


