(DA) PROPOSAL

"national security [means] includes the protection of the people of the Republic and the territorial integrity of the Republic against—

- (a) the threat of use of force or the use of force;
- (b) the following acts:
  - (i) hostile acts of foreign intervention <u>directed at undermining the</u>

    <u>constitutional order of the Republic;</u>
  - (ii) terrorism or terrorist related activities
  - (iii) espionage;
- [ (iv) information peddling;]
  - (iv) exposure of state security matter with <u>the intention of</u>

    <u>undermining the constitutional order of the Republic;</u>
  - (v) <u>exposure of scientific or technological secrets vital to the</u>

    Republic;
  - (vi) sabotage; and
  - (vii) <u>serious</u> violence <u>directed at overthrowing the constitutional</u>

    <u>order of the Republic;</u>
- (c) whether directed from, or committed within, the Republic or not, and

  [includes] acts directed at undermining the capacity of the Republic to
  respond to the use of or the threat of the use of force and carrying out of the
  Republic's responsibilities to any foreign country and international
  organisations in relation to any of the matters referred to in this definition;
- (d) but does not include lawful political activity, advocacy, protest or dissent.
