- We refer to the above matter and wish to enquire whether the Board has formally taken a decision based on the findings and recommended sanction emanating from the disciplinary enquiry that was presided over by Advocate Pretorius SC as, to date, our client has not received any formal communication from the Pan South African Language Board in this regard. In the absence of any contrary indication, our client obviously still regards herself as an employee of your organisation.
- 2. If the Board has indeed formally taken any decision, we hereby request you to urgently furnish us with a copy of the minutes of the meeting where such decision was taken, as well as a copy of the notification, if any, that was sent to our client to enable us to adequately advise our client in protecting her fundamental rights and interests.
- We are also instructed to demand that you urgently pay our client's monthly salary for the months
 of July and August 2011, which you have failed to deposit into her account without any lawful
 cause. Failing this, our instructions are to bring an urgent court application, which will be at your
 ultimate cost.
- 4. The issues raised above are quite urgent and we would therefore appreciate it if they can be treated as such. To this end, we will be happy to have the requested responses by not later than 12h00 on Friday 26 August 2011.
- We await your urgent response.

- We refer to the findings of Adv P Pretorius SC dated 08 June 2011 as well as his sanction dated 24 June 2011 regarding the above matter and confirm that we act on behalf of Mrs Ntombenhle Rosemary Nkosi.
- Our instructions are to lodge an appeal to the Honourable Minister against both the findings and recommended sanction of Adv Pretorius SC as well as the subsequent Board action thereon in terms of the provisions of Regulation 16(14) of the PanSALB Regulations, 2002.
- 3. It is also our instructions that we should register our client's displeasure to the Honourable Minister in the manner in which the Pan South African Language Board has dealt with our client's matter, more particularly on how the final decision was communicated. To date, our client has not received any formal communication from the Pan South African Language Board on the final decision emanating from the disciplinary enquiry that was conducted by Adv Pretorius SC but only received the news from the print and electronic media.
- 4. Be that as it may, our client's appeal is premised on the following factors:
- 4.1 It is respectfully submitted that the Chairperson of the disciplinary enquiry failed to give consideration to the fact that the forensic investigation was not based on the final audit report but rather on a draft report that dld not have Mrs Nkosi's input as she was not accorded an opportunity to respond to any preliminary findings before the final report. Furthermore, the forensic investigation heavily relied on management comments that were furnished by the Deputy Chief Executive Officer and not those furnished by Mrs Nkosi. During the disciplinary enquiry the internal auditors conceded that a satisfactory comment or response from management changes the implications of any finding. Therefore it is submitted that had consideration been given to Mrs Nkosi's comments on the draft internal audit report, most of the findings contained in the forensic investigation report would have been adequately addressed, thus even eliminating the relevant findings.

- 4.1. When the disciplinary enquiry was initiated in 2009 Mrs Nkosi faced about fifty six (56) charges which were eventually reduced to not more than ten (10) by the time the matter was heard, largely owing to further documentation and information coming to light, thus disproving or taking any credence on the findings of the forensic investigation. It is our humble submission that had Mrs Nkosi's witnesses not been intimidated, thus resulting in them not turning up at the enquiry, they would have corroborated Mrs Nkosi's testimony on the credibility of the internal audit report which formed the basis of the forensic investigation.
- Based on the above, it is our submission that since the findings were based on a forensic investigation report that was the result of a flawed process, it should follow that the resultant recommendations should also fall away.
- We trust that you will take the above into consideration in arriving at your decision. Should you
 need any substantive submissions regarding any of the issues contained herein we will gladly
 comply.
