To whom it may concern,

I would like to submit a written response to the national climate change. For a while now my student organisation has been collecting signatures on a petition related to the proposed carbon tax. The petition has gone through various different forms of refinement until the final form asking of the following regarding the carbon tax:

South Africa's proposed carbon tax is set to act as just another tax on South Africans while inadequately addressing issues of climate change - the very problem it was designed to address. This is because the revenue generated will not be earmarked to tackle issues of climate change, rather it will simply flow into government coffers. Because of this many claim that the tax is quite unlikely to result in any significant reduction of greenhouse gas emissions. Given South Africa's pivotal role as hosts and chair of COP 17 at the end of this year, as well as our leading role in Africa and the developing world, and our status as one of the highest emitters of carbon dioxide, we need a stronger measure to ensure a proper response to climate change. In light of the above concerns, we respectfully demand that the South African government earmarks the funds garnered from the carbon tax to deal specifically with issues of climate change adaptation and mitigation, and in doing so enable South Africa's transition towards a lower carbon economy and bolster the resilience of South African communities vulnerable to the effects of climate change. Furthermore, because the tax will put increased financial pressure on the poor through increased electricity costs, we respectfully demand that a portion of the funds is also earmarked to offset regressive impacts on the poor.

## Government of South Africa

South Africa's current response to climate change is ineffective and leaves much to be desired. We need a stronger and more effective South African response to climate change, for although promises made within the Copenhagen Accord were somewhat laudable, the South African government needs to put in place structures that will enable them to achieve those promises and more. Given our pivotal role as hosts and chair of COP 17 at the end of this year, as well as our leading role in Africa and the developing world, and our status as one of the highest emitters of carbon, it is crucial that South Africa takes a stronger stand on climate change. We cannot afford to drop the ball on this.

### What's Wrong?

1. The air quality act does not include carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases as pollutants.
2. The revenue made from the carbon tax proposed by the South African government is not earmarked to specifically tackle issues of climate change.
3. The carbon tax is not mandatory. We feel that because of this, it is a weak measure that does little to slow the effects of climate change.

### What Can We Do?

Combining the above concerns, we feel that South Africa needs to propose stronger measures to deal with climate change, and should thus:

1. Include greenhouse gasses as pollutants under the air quality act.

2. Funds garnered from the carbon tax should be earmarked for a climate fund that deals both with issues of climate change mitigation and adaptation, enabling South Africa's transition towards a lower carbon economy and bolstering the resilience of South African communities vulnerable to the effects of climate change.

3. Work towards making carbon tax mandatory.

If South Africa fails to take climate change seriously now, they could jeopardise global climate change negotiations, and allow the global response to climate change to fall into disarray.

The Petition of the Undersigned:

South Africa's proposed carbon tax is set to act as just another tax on South Africans while inadequately addressing issues of climate change - the very problem it was designed to address. This is because the revenue generated will not be earmarked to tackle issues of climate change, rather it will simply flow into government coffers.
