CLAUSE 8

- 1. on page 6, after line 7, to insert the following paragraph:
 - (j) By the addition of the following subsection:

"(11) For the purposes of this section, 'immediate family', in relation person, means his or her parent, sibling, child, including an adopted child or a step-child, or spouse (whether by statutory, customary or religious law), and including a life partner who is a person living with that person as if they were married to each other.".

CLAUSE 35

- 1. On page 14, in line 3, to omit "are" and substitute "[are] is ".
- 2. On page 14, in line 5, to omit "are" and substitute "[are] is".

CLAUSE 36

On page 14, in line 9, to omit "Every [lecturer and]" and to substitute "[Every lecturer and] A".

PUBLIC HEARINGS REPORT OF THE PORTFOLIO COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION, CULTURE, SPORT AND RECREATION ON FURTHER EDUCATION AND TRAINING COLLEGES AMENDMENT BILL (B13B- 2011)

1. INTRODUCTION

The Speaker referred the Further Education and Training Colleges Amendment Bill (B13B-2011) (the Bill) to the Portfolio Committee on Education, Culture, Sport and Recreation (the Committee) after it was referred to the Legislature by the Chairperson of the NCOP. The Bill is classified as a section 76 Bill, viz. an ordinary bill affecting provinces. The Committee, as part of its law making processes, decided to conduct public hearings to solicit inputs or comments from the general public and stakeholders.

1.1 Purpose

The aim of the Bill is to amend:

- the Further Education and Training College Act, 2006, so as to remove all references to provincial authority;
- to substitute functions previously assigned to the Member of the Executive Council with the Minister;
- to remove all references to the Head of Department and substitute with the Director-General;
- to provide for the prohibition of a member of Council or a member of staff to conduct business, directly or indirectly with the public further education and training college which business is in conflict of interest with the concerned public further education and training college;



to provide for transitional arrangements with regard to public service posts and educator posts, staff, disciplinary measures; and policy made by the Member of the Executive Council under the principal Act or any provincial law, necessary for the effective governance, management and funding of public further education and training colleges; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

1.2 METHOD OF WORK

The Committee met on 02 November 2011 to be briefed by the Chairperson of the Committee Hon NC Mamabolo on Further Education and Training Colleges Amendment Bill (B13B-2011)

On receipt of the Bill, the Portfolio Committee agreed to conduct public hearings on radio talk shows. Ligwalagwala FM, Ikwekwezi FM and Bushbuckridge community radio station were identified for public comments and inputs. Advertisements were also made in newspapers for comments and inputs e.g. Sowetan. Members of the Committee conducted public hearings on the above mentioned radio stations.

Following deliberations after provincial legislatures conferred negotiating mandates, proposed amendments that were effected on the Bill (B13B-2011), to be finalized by the NCOP Select Committee on 30 November 2011. The Committee met on the 25 November 2011 to consider the proposed amendments effected on the Bill and agreed with the proposed amendments.

2. DELIBERATIONS

2.1 Inputs and Comments

The public supports the amendments proposed on the Bill. However; there were concerns and clarity seeking questions raised on some clauses regarding the Bill, which the Committee managed to respond to.



3. RECOMMENDATION

The Portfolio Committee recommends that delegates of the Mpumalanga Province in the NCOP should be conferred with a mandate to vote in favour of the Bill.

4. CONCLUSION

The Chairperson would like to thank the Members of the Portfolio Committee, for their participation during and after the proceedings of the public hearings.

Lastly, on behalf of the Committee, the Chairperson would like to request the House to adopt this Report.
