

## 1. Purpose

To present progress in the filling of vacancies in the Department for Rural Development and Land Reform and the Commission on Restitution of Land Rights, for noting.

# 2. Summary of report is as follows:-

2.1 The annual report for 2010/2011 indicated the vacancy rate as at 31 March 2011 as follows:

2.2 The vacancy rate as at 27 February 2012 is as follows:

- 2.3 The establishment has grown by 398 funded positions and this accounts for the increase in the vacancy rate.
- 2.4 16 Senior Management positions have been submitted for approval and this includes the Deputy Director-Generals for Land Reform and Administration and for Rural Infrastructure Development. The filling of these posts will reduce the vacancy rate.
