

National Air Transport Sawices

- Department of Transport role in Aviation industry is one of principle enabler and a Regulator
- Deregulation of the Domestic Market since 1990
- Removal barriers of entry into the domestic market
- Ensure the provision of air transport services to meet accessibility and mobility of all South Africans


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National Air Transport Sarvices cont

- Promote competition and lower air fares
- Emergence of low cost airlines i.e 1Time,
 Khulula, Mango etc.
- Development of the Airlift Strategy to support national economic growth and promote market access.

Aviation Regulatory Framework

- Establish regulatory bodies i.e. IASC, ASLC, SACAA, ATNS, ACSA and RC
- Establish air transport services on the basis of equity of opportunities
- Access to international markets managed through bilateral air transport system
- Stable and predictable provision of aviation services



Regional Unitiatives

- RSA signatory to the Abuja Treaty for the liberalisation of air services within the Continent (YD)
- Review of the National Aviation Policy to incorporate provisions and principles of liberalization
- Airlift Strategy increase capacity ahead of demand to enhance market access and competition
- Commercial co-operations of local and regional operators i.e South African Airlink/Swazi Airlink, SAX/Congo Express

Rectional Unitabilities done

- Emergence of regional start-up airlines i.e. Zambezi Airlines, Korong Airlines, Fly Kumba etc
- Increased regional connectivity and accessibility through low cost model


Aviation Regulation/ Framework

- Investment friendly sector and increased access to air transport market
- Enabling an attractive transport environment for tourism and trade
- Increase in African connectivity and access for development as well as the reduction of transport costs

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National Airport Development Plan (NADP)

- Need for integrated airport development identified
- NADP being developed and will form blue print for all current and future airport developments
- Main focus on ensuring development of suitable airport developments to meet the needs of users countrywide
- Promotes concept of IDZ and need for international airport designation, with a focus on creation of demand to ensure economic viability.

- Exposure to careers available in aviation industry
- Enhance learner career path and scarce skills
- Free exposure to air shows
