The nominee's details are detailed in the attached CV.

Haroun Moolla has extensive experience with the SABC having been one of the first two Indian managers appointed in 2003 (the other being the late Ameen Akhalwaya).

Haroun began his career at the SABC as Financial Manager of TSS (NNTV) and progressed to General Manager Finance of the new TV Division in January 1996. He was personally responsible for the launch of the new SABC TV channels in February 1996. He was responsible for the entire budget of the TV Division.

Haroun returned to the SABC in 1999 as General Manager of the new Radio Division. He was responsible for the finances of 18 radio stations. During this period many experienced managers left the organisation and he had to simultaneously head up the finances of Radio, TV and Operations.

Haroun was deployed to the corporatisation team by the CEO IN January 2001 to prepare the SABC to be transformed

into SABC Ltd and also to prepare mandates for commercial and public broadcasting.

Haroun left the SABC in July 2001 to become the first Chief Financial Officer of ICASA.

Haroun has extensive experience in the governance of state institutions and is a very knowledgeable in the PFMA. He understands the imperatives of public broadcasting extremely well.

I am sure Haroun will serve the SABC very diligently and honourably.
